Please use Arial or Helvetica font, 12 pt throughout except 14 pt **bold** type for the title and 10 pt for affiliations. Do not capitalize letters in the title. Italicize gene names and latin names of species but other than that, please minimize the use of special characters and formatting. Underline the presenting author. Give full names of all authors (first name first). Give abbreviated affiliations (street address and ZIP code not required). Use single spacing and separate title, authors and affiliations from the abstract body as shown. **DO NOT include tables or images. Please be concise, DO NOT exceed 300 words** (title, names, and affiliations are excluded from the word count). Please use standard English and spell-check your text, as we will not be able to edit it after submission. Whether your abstract will be selected by the Program Committee for oral versus poster presentation will also depend on how well the abstract is written. We look forward to receiving your abstracts and seeing you in Ceske Budejovice (Budweis).
